## Bow hunter's vest by Primos

An independent personal review by Frank Berbuir.

Primos' Bowhunter's Vest is not just another vest with lots of pockets for your gear, it's specifically custom-designed around all that bow hunters may want to carry with them in the field: calls, rangefinder, flashlight, scents, gloves, mask, multi-tool, small binocular, water bottle, wind checker. The vest organises your gear by providing specific places to hold specific items so you always know where they are when you need them. The mesh pockets on the inside of the vest allow you to see what is stored in them at a glance.

When wearing the Primos vest there is nothing for your bowstring to catch on because the vest cinches your clothes in, so your shot is unobstructed. If you are hunting from an open tree stand, the vest can be worn over your safety harness as well. Its unique safety-harness opening will keep your harness strap from binding behind your neck.

The vest also has hand-warmer pockets with a soft lining for when you are sitting in the stand or blind in the cold, dark morning hours. In addition, there is a bow-holder strap where you can stick in your bow to keep your arm relaxed while you're standing.

Deep-cut arm holes allow use of the vest over a cold-weath-

er coat. On the front and side the vest has mesh vents to help prevent body heat build-up.

In addition to three calls, compass, four-inch fixed-blade knife, a Leatherman, half-litre water bottle, range finder, screw-in bow-holder, windchecker, gloves and mask, cell phone, archery hex tool and two big cereal or granola bars, I could even put my video camera in one of the pockets – along with a camera tripod. So I did not need a rucksack or backpack anymore. The camo pattern is Realtree Hardwoods Green.
